Official Q&A

Q: When did you first develop an interest in seduction arts?

A: It is really no exaggeration when I say that I have been crazy about women since I was a child. For as long as I can remember, I have always chased women and I've always had moderate success. However, my interest in the seduction arts, as defined by pick-up artists, began in high school when I discovered David DeAngelo's "Cocky Comedy" series while surfing the web for funny videos. My web search led me to the book, "The Game: Penetrating the Secret Society of Pick-up Artists" by Neil Strauss. I was instantly intrigued and continued searching the Internet about the topic. The rest is history.

Q: What's the most valuable lesson you learned during your training?

A: I learned that there is an amazing personality at the core of every individual with the capacity to achieve great things with women and in life. However, you will not be able to externally express this core personality until you drop your ego, and evaluate your flaws and strengths in an objective manner.

Q: In your opinion, what are the key characteristics of a successful pick-up artist?

A: A successful pick-up artist has a passion for the game, knows his strengths, knows his weaknesses, constantly improves, has a superior level of social experience and has balls of steel. Being a pick-up artist isn't a title given to casual seducers. Becoming a successful pick-up artist is a lifestyle. Once you succeed as a pick-up artist, you use those skills to become a successful man, which I value over simply being a pick-up artist.

Q: Who has been your biggest influence?

A: I have had many influences in my journey to becoming the man I am today. My biggest influence was my grandfather who once told me, "Have a girlfriend for every day of the week. If one cancels on you, don't see them until the next week on their day. Keep Sunday open so you can go to church." He's the one who encouraged me to approach women as a child, and gave me psychology books to read when I was 13 years old. I wouldn't be nearly as socially experienced or enthused about what pick-up artists do had it not been for my grandfather sparking my interest in social dynamics at a young age.

Q: How have you impacted the lives of the men that you've consulted and trained?

A: The men who have consulted and trained with me have a stronger grasp of who they are and use that inner strength to constantly improve their lives. Most of the men that I've met in the past didn't know what they wanted from women, but now that they have options, they no longer have a fear of settling for an unattractive partner.

Q: What has been the biggest milestone of your career?

A: The biggest milestone of my career is having sex with hot women that I thought were way out of my league in the past. When I completed my first boot camp, I was ecstatic over the fact that a woman who I thought was extremely attractive expressed her interest in me as well. To sleep with a woman like that for the first time blew my mind.

Q: What makes you a recognized leader in the PUA community?

A: I have a life outside of the PUA community that allows me to meet all kinds of interesting people and connect with them for mutually beneficial relationships. The fact that I am pursuing interests and excelling in them, while attracting beautiful women into my life, is a testament to the beliefs that I teach.

Q: When working with clients, what are some of the key factors that prevent men from succeeding? How do you help them overcome these obstacles?

A: It takes most men a while to grasp the concept of sexually escalating with women. They either wait too long or go too fast during the process. During the fieldwork portion of the boot camp, I help students to feel comfortable escalating sexually by encouraging them to actually escalate. This is something that the student must do in order to succeed, and over time they will do it in a way that women enjoy.

Q: What's the most valuable piece of advice you could give to a man struggling with meeting and attracting women?

A: Experience leads to success and failure. However, with enough success comes confidence, and women love confident men. You should always seek competency to match your confidence. So basically, get out there and just do it.
