Official Q&A

Q: When did you first develop an interest in seduction arts?

A: I'd say I first developed an interest in seduction arts at the age of 12 when I slapped a girl's ass. But unfortunately it took a long time for it to kick in. I was first introduced to the PUA community in 2006.

Q: What's the most valuable lesson you learned during your training?

A: Self-development is one of the most important parts of pick up. You really have to commit to evolving and becoming the best person you can possibly be. It's the most important investment you'll ever make, and you'll reap huge rewards from it. Self-discipline is also hugely important. Self-discipline is just like a muscle, and it develops just like a muscle. The more you work it out the better and stronger it gets.

Q: In your opinion, what are the key characteristics of a successful pick-up artist?

A: To be a successful pick up artist, you have to have a natural sense of curiosity and genuine interest in exploring every aspect of seduction arts. You also have to have the balls to do what it takes to become successful.

Q: How have you impacted the lives of the men that you've consulted and trained?

A: It's great to read testimonials after our boot camps and to get emails from guys who have benefited from the coaching. I love the fact that I can help men get to a point in their lives where they no longer have to fear being alone, or have to settle for something they don't want.

Q: What has been the biggest milestone of your career?

A: As a coach, I get to impart knowledge upon students that will change their lives forever, and that's incredibly significant. But the biggest milestone of my career is actually more personal. Through pick up, I've developed a greater and deeper understanding of myself. And to me, that has been invaluable.

Q: What makes you a recognized leader in the PUA community?

A: I'm one of the few Latino pick up artists and coaches in the world, so I have great insight into helping Latino men overcome their challenges. Additionally, I have winged with the majority of Los Angeles.

Q: When working with clients, what are some of the key factors that prevent men from succeeding? How do you help them overcome these obstacles?

A: A lot of students are hindered by a lack of preparation. It's important to develop a solid game plan, and unfortunately, a lot of guys fail to do that. So that's one of the things that we concentrate on heavily, sitting down with students and helping them to develop a solid plan of action that will get them the results they want.

Q: What's the most valuable piece of advice you could give to a man struggling with meeting and attracting women?

A: You have to let go of the ego. Once you do, you'll develop a greater sense of self, and self-respect.
