Official Q&A

Q: When did you first develop an interest in seduction arts?

A: On my 22nd birthday, my friend bought me the book titled 'The Game' By Neil Strauss as a gift. After reading a third of the book, I was hungry for more knowledge from the actual source as the book was more of an introduction to the game and not a 'How to' guide. So I went off to learn Mystery's Method via his DVD and have continued to grow after joining the ABCs of Attraction.

Q: What's the most valuable lesson you learned during your training?

A: I learned that you get out what you put in. I see many people in pickup who expect to get good overnight or just give up too easily without investing a significant amount of time in it.

Q: In your opinion, what are the key characteristics of a successful pick-up artist?

A: Someone who never stops learning. Pickup is an art and hence you can never really master it. Even after learning pickup for 7 years, I still have sticking points. Although my sticking points may be different from someone who has only just started studying, but never the less I still have some. I still learn new things every time I go out.

Q: Who has been your biggest influence?

A: Definitely Mystery as Mystery method was the first system that I have learned. I have gotten success from using the structured system, much like that of the ABCs. I finally got to meet JT in the flesh in early 2014 and we became good friends and still keep in contact till this day.

Q: How have you impacted the lives of the men that you've consulted and trained?

A: One of my biggest achievements was definitely helping my High School friend learn pickup. He was going through depression; he was 26 at the time and was a virgin still. He agreed to pay me to teach him. I was his last resort. We went out once a week for 2 months and he finally met his dream girl through a cold approach. They're still together till this day! I have never seen him so happy in his life.

Q: What has been the biggest milestone of your career?

A: Realizing that non-Asian girls like me and wanted to date me. Also, pickup has allowed me to travel the world to teaching and I have even been recognized by random people in the club.

Q: What makes you a recognized leader in the PUA community?

A: I am well respected in Sydney as one of the top PUAs and well respected in other PUA communities outside of ABCs of Attraction. I also have my own YouTube channel where I do more entertainment style pick-up videos just for fun which others seem to enjoy.

Q: When working with clients, what are some of the key factors that prevent men from succeeding? How do you help them overcome these obstacles?

A: Definitely their limiting beliefs. Students need to realize that looks, money, height, and race means very little in pick up. This might be a factor for 10% of girls, but we're not trying to pick up gold diggers, vain, or closed minded individuals. Having said that, if you come across a girl who falls into that category, there is a chance that you may get rejected or experience a bad reaction. Remember that you don't want to date that type of girl anyway, so rejection is actually the perfect screening process.

Q: What's the most valuable piece of advice you could give to a man struggling with meeting and attracting women?

A: Be genuine, honest, and confident and most importantly be YOUR BEST self. Remember that no one is born naturally confident, fashionable, or fit. It is their life experiences that have a major effect on these traits. You have to build it up yourself.
